



In no other UN body is there such a gulf between aspiration and reality as in the Geneva-based Human Rights Council. While unjust states such as North Korea, Iran, Venezuela or even Mianmar are hardly ever discussed or criticized there, this is constantly the case with Israel – right from the start.

Just one year after the UN Human Rights Council was founded, a fixed agenda was introduced, whereby the “human rights situation in Palestine and other occupied Arab territories” must be discussed every time under [agenda item 7](#). There is no comparable agenda item for any other area of conflict. Accordingly, Israel is frequently condemned.
