A necessary war. Since taking power in 1979, the mullahs in Tehran have threatened and terrorised not only the existence of the Jewish state of Israel, Jews around the world and the entire West, but increasingly their own people as well. The current war waged by the United States and Israel against the Islamo-fascists in Tehran is therefore necessary and justified. Whether it will lead to the fall of the regime remains uncertain.
