A test case for Europe. In the West, especially in Europe, large segments of society view the war waged by the United States and Israel against Iran's mullah regime with caution or even outright opposition. No all-clear. The number of antisemitic assaults, insults or graffiti in Switzerland fell in 2025 compared with 2024. But it remains clearly higher than it was before Hamas's massacre on 7 October 2023. And on social media, antisemitic activity even increased sharply again last year. For many years, SRF, the public-service radio and television broadcaster in German-speaking Switzerland, has been anti-Israel and has repeatedly been reprimanded by its supervisory bodies.
