Nothing learned. Under pressure from voters dissatisfied with his conduct in office and from his vice president J. D. Vance, who is already speculating about the next presidential candidacy, US President Donald Trump has signed a declaration of intent (Memorandum of Understanding, MoU) with Iran. In doing so, the US president shows that he has learned nothing from history and understands nothing about the present-day Middle East.
